

Volunteer with PeopleStories - Frequently Asked Questions

1) IS THERE AN AGE REQUIREMENT FOR VOLUNTEERING?

For volunteering groups involving higher level of physical work such as building a classroom, volunteers need to be 18 years of age or over.

For other volunteering groups involving mild physical work such as SportsForGood and UnleashMyTalent, we welcome youth at the age of 8 or above to join together with their guardian.

Mature volunteers who are 65 or over would need to provide evidence of good health condition and mobility as most of our volunteering tasks are physical.

Age restriction is specified on the program.

2) HOW LONG CAN I VOLUNTEER FOR?

We understand that our volunteers have other priorities in life hence volunteering period can be flexible. In general, volunteering experiences are either 4 nights or 7 nights. With approval from PeopleStories, volunteers may extend their volunteering experience as required and feasible.

3) WHAT IS THE MAIN LANGUAGE USED WHERE THE PROJECT IS LOCATED?

English is frequently spoken throughout the region however at varying levels.

4) WILL I BE THE ONLY VOLUNTEER?

To provide an authentic and intimate volunteering experience, our group size is limited to a maximum of 6. From time to time, we will also have solo volunteer participating which is dependent on applications.

5) HOW WILL I GET TO THE PROJECT LOCATION?

Transportation to and from the project location is provided accordingly and included in the overall costs. Should the volunteers want to take private transportation or outside of the general routine, such arrangements can be made with an additional cost.

6) HOW OFTEN DOES SOMEONE FROM PEOPLESTORIES VISIT WHERE THE VOLUNTEERS WORK TAKES PLACE?

A representative from PeopleStories will be accompanying each volunteering group. They will be working alongside the volunteers with other local staff and community members.

7) IS THERE ANY PREPARATION NEEDED BEFORE I GO?

You will need to complete an online application form and arrange for your own flight. We will take care of all the rest. Once your volunteering application is approved and two weeks prior to the commencement of your volunteering experience, you will be receiving a volunteer handbook. Follow the recommendations from this handbook and be prepared for a meaningful life experience.

9) DO I NEED TO HAVE A SPECIAL SKILL SET TO VOLUNTEER?

Absolutely not! PeopleStories welcomes volunteers with an open-minded, positive attitude and genuine willingness to help others to join our volunteering experience.

This is with the exception of skills volunteering that requirements will be specified as part of the on-line application form. An example can be a 'Mathematics Teacher' role, which we will be seeking for a volunteer who has sound knowledge of mathematics.

10) HOW DO I APPLY?
