The PeopleStories MDS was brought to life by transforming an old Tuk-Tuk into a mobile classroom equipped with digital learning tools like laptops. This 'school-on-wheels' travels to rural communities, facilitating digital learning anytime, anywhere.

The MDS provides quality digital learning alongside blended in-person activities, including group projects, digital games, and riddles, effectively enhancing the Cambodian government curriculum and offering children the best opportunities to learn and complete their education.

Andreas Fischer, Chief e-learning designer and volunteer at PeopleStories, added, ***"Our Critical Thinking Course is making significant strides, empowering 97% of the children to enhance their reasoning abilities and enabling 96% to meet the reasoning standard after completing the course. That's a huge impact!"***

Since its inception in 2022, the PeopleStories MDS has successfully delivered over 30,000 learning hours to more than 1,200 children in villages across Cambodia. These children, along with many of their teachers, have never used a laptop before or experienced digital learning.

Victoria Miloschewsky says: ***"The Mobile Digital School has proven the concept of deploying professional web-based digital learning experiences in remote environments without needing the internet. I am proud to say PeopleStories is the first to bring Mobile Digital School to rural villages in Cambodia!"***
